- 3. Letter from your registrar confirming timing of Stage 2 registration audit.
- 4. Letter from your registrar confirming completion of Stage 1 audit and timing for Stage 2 registration audit.
- 5. Confirmation of registration for ISO 14001 implementation training (e.g., AIAG, Ford's FTDC course) and confirmation of registrar contract with projected certification audit date.

For suppliers that have not already submitted certificate of registration to your respective customer, you must notify your customer by March 21, 2003, as to your progress in meeting the requirement and your contingency plan in lieu of non-compliance to the above dates.
